David Jones was a very busy man and acording to his ledgers from 1850 we have a look at his work and life until 1861 when he died at the age of 36. In the ledgers he had a page for each of his customers. In the begining his work was to clean and repair the clocks. In addition he also helped in the harvest as was needed. He was a hooper, this work was to place a band of thin wood or metal around a wooden bucket, beer barrel or salt tub to keep them in place.
