

Moses Evans

1744 – 1819



Ganed Moses Evans ar Fai 25ain 1744 mab Owen a Jane Evans, Tŷ Gwyn, Llanddoged. Roeddynt yn denantiaid i stad Gwydir. Deallir fod Owen Evans yn gwneud clociau ac mae un wedi ei ddyddio ganddo yn 1777. Erbyn 1770 Moses a'i fam oedd yn talu'r rhent.

Priododd Moses gyda Jane Jones, Llangernyw ar Fedi 18ed 1779 ac aethont i fyw i Pentre Wern, Llangernyw. Roedd Moses wedi gwneud llawer iawn o glocliau wyneb pres a rhai gwyn yn ogystal â gwneud oriawr. Bu farw Jane yn 1817 a Moses yn 1819 ac mae'r ddau wedi eu claddu ym mynwent Llangernyw.

Moses Evans was born on May 25th 1744 son of Owen and Jane Evans, Tŷ Gwyn, Llanddoged. They were tenants of the Gwydir estate. We know that Owen Evans also made clocks and there is one dated 1777. By 1770 Moses and his mother were paying the rent.

Moses Evans married Jane Jones from Llangernyw on September 18th 1779 and they went to live in Pentre Wern, Llangernyw. Moses made brass and white faced clocks, also watches. Jane died in 1817 and Moses in 1819 and they have been buried at Llangernyw cemetery.
